From the founder - Nick Marshall...

A number of years ago I noticed I was coaching a family that had one child in my training squad and the surf club while their sibling, living with Down Syndrome, was unable to do nippers, and join the club and be part of the Nobbys Family. So, after a long period of planning and a number of discussions in 2014, the idea for the Albatross Nippers was born. An inclusive surf lifesaving nipper program that catered to all abilities and allowed some families hat had become a little socially isolated to come back to the beach and enjoy the nipper and surf club experience.

Who is it for?

Any person living with a disability that can't easily integrate straight in to their age specific nipper group. Our goal is always to keep you with your own age group and complete nippers with them, however sometimes the age specific surf activities and proficiency tests are unachievable. So, in this case we have the Albatross Nippers age group to continue your nipper journey.

How to join?

Best way to join is follow the "Albatross Nippers" facebook page and complete the paper work provided online. This way when you arrive on the first day there is less to do.

Competition

In 2019 we became the first group of nippers living with a disability to participate in competition and we continue to do this at every seasons Queensland State championships. This season that is on 24th March at Burleigh Heads.

Here at Nobby's, the Red and Yellow is certainly at the core of us as a club. Our patrols are based around family and friendship to achieve a shared goal of zero preventable deaths on our beach.

We have 9 strong patrol teams who keep our beach goers safe over the patrol season. At Nobby's we patrol once every two weeks for an AM or PM shift with change over at 12:15-12:30pm.

We are a real family here at Nobby's and aim to help each others out when we can with patrolling.

Who are the 'youth'?

Any member within the Club between 13 and 18 years of age. Typically, this is the age where teens disengage and 'drop out' of community sports and programs. However, these members of our club play a vital role in ensuring there will be members around in years to come to mentor our nippers, take up committee positions, patrol captaincies...and much more!

THIS SEASON THERE WILL BE A SURF SPORTS LEVY. FOR THOSE WANTING TO COMPETE IT WILL BE A ONE-OFF FEE, TO COVER THE ENTRY COSTS OF ALL CORE CARNIVALS.

U8s-U10s: Club to cover the cost (core carnivals only). U11s-U15s & Opens-Masters: \$50 levy includes entry to all core carnivals.

Admin Fee: If a member wishes to pay for a carnival individually i.e. a member who has not paid the levy OR wishes to compete in an additional carnival (not core), an additional 20% of the entry fee, albeit early bird, general, or late entry depending on the time of processing, will be charged.
